

Directive of NASK's Director

No. 245/2014

as of 17 November 2014

on limiting by NASK the provision of Administrative and Technical Service directly to natural persons not conducting business activity

Under § 15 item 1 of the Organizational Statutes of Naukowa i Akademicka Sieć Komputerowa – a research institute (“NASK”), I order what follows:

§ 1

Due to the enforcement of a consecutive phase of deregulation of the domain name market in Poland, commenced in December 2002, and in order to meet the growing expectations of that market, in particular, the entities with which NASK is bound by the agreement on the cooperation within the scope of Administrative and Technical Service (“Partners”), and perceiving the need for strengthening the market positions of those entities and for increasing the availability of services, from 1 December 2014 NASK ceases to accept any tenders to conclude the Agreement on the Maintenance of .pl Domain Name and provision of the Administrative and Technical Service directly to the Subscribers being natural persons not conducting a business activity.

§ 2

From 1 December 2014 the conclusion of the Agreement with NASK by the Tenderers, referred to in paragraph 1, will only be possible via the Partners, specified in the current list of Partners, published at the NASK's website. Tenders submitted to NASK before the enforcement date of this Directive shall be examined in accordance with the current rules.

§ 3

From 1 December 2014 the extension of the subject matter of the Agreements on the Maintenance of .pl Domain Name additionally by the Administrative and Technical Service directly to the Subscribers, referred to in paragraph 1, will no longer be allowed. Applications filed to NASK before the enforcement date of this Directive shall be examined in accordance with the current rules.

§ 4

From 1 December 2014 NASK ceases to accept and execute the Changes of Subscribers of the .pl domain names which would result with the provision of the Administrative and Technical Service by NASK directly for the Subscribers, referred to in paragraph 1. Applications filed to NASK before the enforcement date of this Directive shall be examined in accordance with the current rules.

§ 5

The Administrative and Technical Service, provided for the Subscribers, referred to in paragraph 1, on the basis of the Agreements concluded before 1 December 2014, shall be effected in an unchanged manner, i.e. in accordance with the binding .pl Domain Names Regulations as of 18 December 2006.

§ 6

Notions used in this Directive carry the meaning vested in the .pl Domain Names Regulations as of 18 December 2006.

§ 7

This Directive shall enter into force as of 1 December 2014.
